The appointed resident will serve a 2-year term from February 1, 2025 to November 30, 2026, unless Council directs otherwise.

Members must be residents of the rural Municipality of the County of Kings and may hold office for a term not exceeding four years.

Meetings will be held as required by disputes filed. Honorariums are paid quarterly based on meeting attendance.
