Aylesford Lake Public Beach open for 2024 season

KINGS COUNTY, NS – The extended season for Aylesford Lake Public Beach is now underway.

The popular recreation destination owned and operated by the Municipality of the County of Kings opened for the season June 15, the earliest it has opened for public use in recent history.

Aylesford Lake's public beach, playground and picnic area located at 580 North River Road will be open daily from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Lifeguards will be on duty from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The beach will remain open for the 2024 season



until 8 p.m. on Sept. 15 to extend the season beyond the typical Labour Day weekend end date.

Paddlers of all skill levels are welcome to try the Municipality's free kayak and paddleboard Ioan program, with walk-up loans starting on July 1 and online reservations opening on July 5.

- The Municipality makes the paddling equipment available to visitors of Aylesford Lake Beach at no cost.
- 50-minute loan sessions beginning on the hour will be offered between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., with a mix of weekday and weekend options available on a first-come, first-served basis.

In addition to free kayak and stand-up paddleboard loans, Aylesford Lake Beach features an inclusive indoor washroom and changing facility, accessible parking lot and boardwalk, sheltered playground, paved pathways to key service areas on site, accessible beach and water access, and a playbox with yard games and beach toys available for beachgoers to borrow.
