

Aylesford Lake Beach Reopening Today

Aylesford Lake Public Beach is reopening at 1 p.m. today (July 11).

The public beach was closed as a precautionary measure due to higher than acceptable bacteria counts in water tests reported on July 9. Two consecutive water quality tests conducted following the beach closure showed that it is safe to reopen Aylesford Lake Public Beach.

Water quality is monitored regularly at Aylesford Lake Beach to ensure the beach is safe for swimming. The Municipality consults with Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change before a beach closure and prior to reopening the beach after a closure.

The Municipality of the County of Kings apologizes for any inconvenience beach closures may cause.
