

How to Confirm You're on the Voters' List Before the Municipal Election in October

Residents of the Municipality of the County of Kings are encouraged to go online or contact the Election Office to confirm they're registered to vote in the upcoming Municipal Election.

Go online or contact the Election Office directly to confirm the contact information that will be used to mail out Voter Information Letters is current and correct:

- 1. Use the "Check your voter registration" tool at <u>www.countyofkings.ca/election</u>
- 2. Contact the Election Office directly by emailing **election@countyofkings.ca** or calling **902-690-VOTE (8683).**

Voter Information Letters contain important instructions required for the e-voting process. These letters will be mailed to eligible voters in early October. It is especially important to confirm you're on the Voters' List if you've recently moved or turned 18.

To be eligible to vote

- you must be 18 years or older on the first advance polling day (Oct. 10)
- you must be a Canadian citizen on the first advance polling day (Oct. 10)
- you must have been ordinarily resident in Nova Scotia for at least six months immediately preceding the first advance polling day (by April 9)
- you must be a resident of the Municipality of the County of Kings since immediately before the first advance polling day (Oct. 10)
- You are not otherwise disqualified to vote in the Municipal and School Board elections

Please contact the Election Office if you do not receive a Voter Information Letter by Oct. 4. Voting will take place from noon Oct. 10 to 7 p.m. Oct. 19.
