June 2024 Fast Facts from Council Chambers

“Fast Facts from Council Chambers” is a quick summary of some key takeaways from Council meetings held in June 2024. For more background information, use the links below each list of motions to find agenda packages and meeting recordings.

Motions from the June 4 Municipal Council meeting:

Municipal Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Hold a Public Hearing regarding an application to rezone a portion of 2809 Lovett Road in Coldbrook from Residential One and Two Unit (R2) Zone to the Residential Mixed Density (R3) Zone to allow additional residential units on the property.
- Hold a Public Hearing regarding an application to rezone 543 Windsor Street, Kingston from the Residential One Unit (R1) Zone to the Residential One and Two Unit (R2) Zone to allow the development of a two-unit dwelling.
- Approve an application to rezone 1.1 acres of a vacant parcel fronting on Middle Dyke Road in North Kentville from Residential One Unit (R1) to the Residential One and Two Unit (R2) Zone.
- Repeal Policy ADMIN-01-004: Crosswalk Guard and adopt Policy FIN-05-027: School Crossing Guard Funding.
- Approve that Municipal Council and Committee of the Whole do not meet in August 2024 unless required for urgent and pressing matters.
- Proclaim June 2024 as Indigenous History Month in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Proclaim June 21, 2024, as Indigenous Peoples Day in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Proclaim June 2024 as Pride Month in the Municipality of the County of Kings.
- Support the submission of a Provincial Capital Assistance Program application related to engineering studies and possible system upgrade designs for the Halls Harbour Water Cooperative’s potable water supply.

Motions from the June 18 Special Council meeting:

Municipal Council passed motions approving the following actions:

- Award a one-year extension to Contract #23-24: Sludge Disposal Services to Loomer's Pumping Services Limited (April 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024) with a contract value of \$156,413.
- Award Contract #24-07: Municipal EV Charging Stations to Roscoe Construction Limited for \$693,682.31.
- Give first reading to amend By-law 93, the Private Road Maintenance & Improvement Charge By-law.
