



Recreation Services Summer Paddling Program Position – (2 positions)

Wage: \$18.00 per hour

Work term: June 16, 2025–Aug 29, 2025 (Some flexibility may be negotiated with term end date.)

Hours: Open 7 days a week, staff available on site between 9am – 6pm; staff will be scheduled for 35 hrs/wk with some daytime weekend work required.

Hours & Location: This position is primarily based at the municipally owned and operated Aylesford Lake Public Beach. The Public Beach is open daily from mid-June to Mid-September with lifeguards present from 10am - 6pm daily. The Summer Paddle Program begins in July and runs 7 days a week; staff will be scheduled to work 35 hrs/wk including a variation of weekday and weekend shifts.

Summer Paddling Program Staff: Working with a Team Lead, Paddling Staff will collaboratively work to deliver three, 3-day Paddle camps. These camps will focus on fun and include instructing participants (aged 8-13) on basic kayaking skills, stroke development, basic SUP use, boating/water safety, and engaging onshore activities. Paddling Staff are responsible for ensuring the safety of participants, interacting with parents/guardians, and collaborating with the Municipality's recreation staff.

Summer Paddling Staff will also be responsible for the public Kayak/Paddle Board loan program, which includes:

- providing access for the public to borrow kayaks/stand up paddle boards during the days Aylesford Lake Beach;
- signing kayaks and paddle boards in and out;
- providing kayaking/paddle board support for individuals wishing to have a leader on the water while using the equipment.

An ideal candidate for the Summer Paddling Program will be an outgoing, adaptable, caring, and creative high school or post-secondary student. Previous experience working with younger youth in a physical activity and/or camp setting as well as experience Kayaking, Paddle Boarding, Lifeguard Certification, and familiarity with Aylesford Lake are considered assets. We encourage enthusiastic, organized, and motivated self-starters to apply today. Training including Basic Kayak Certification will be provided to all Lake Staff.
